

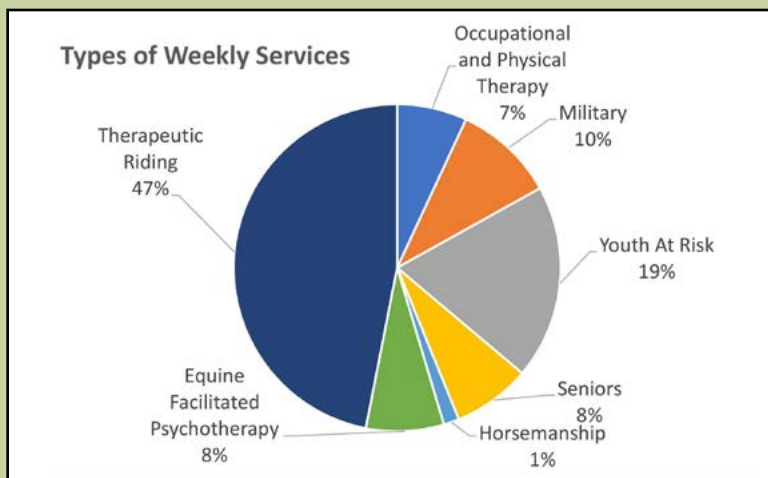
Northern Virginia Therapeutic Riding Program 2019 At A Glance

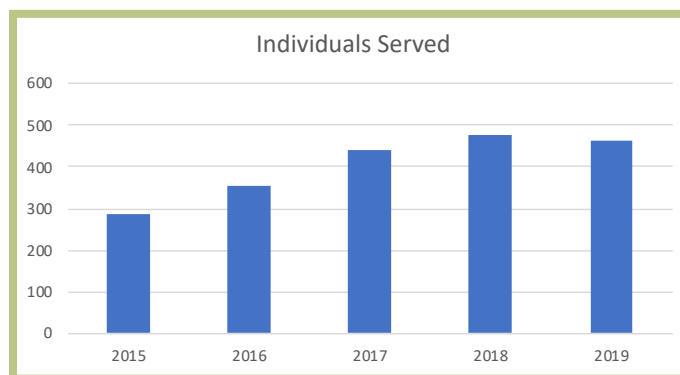

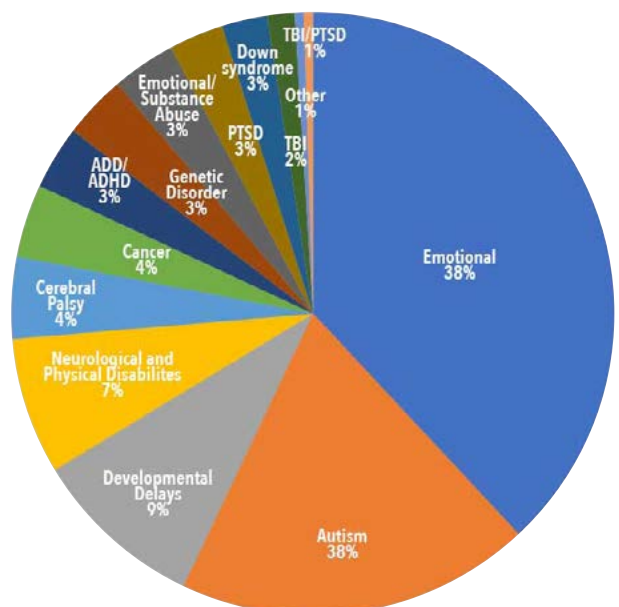
